Introduction to Print-on-Demand for Adult or Childrens Coloring Books

What is Print-on-Demand?

Print-on-Demand (POD) is a publishing model where books are printed individually as orders come in, rather than in large batches.

For coloring book creators, this means:

- No upfront inventory costs
- No need to store physical books
- The ability to offer a wide range of designs without financial risk
- Easy updates and modifications to your books

So you're able to create these books in a way that has very minimal cost outlay and are able to print as they're required rather than having to (like the old days), print hundreds of copies and potentially be left with a ton of them that just didn't sell.

This is a much easier way to do it, so the company manages printing and delivery, you just create them, set it up and get paid if/when people buy a copy.

Why is POD So Great for Coloring Book Creators?

- 1. Low startup costs: You only need to invest in creating your designs.
- 2. Minimal risk: No unsold inventory to worry about.
- 3. **Global reach**: POD platforms often offer worldwide distribution.
- 4. Creative freedom: Easily test new ideas and concepts.
- 5. Passive income potential: Once set up, books can generate ongoing revenue.

The POD Process for Coloring Books

In this report we'll outline the steps to creating and publishing coloring books using one of the more commonly used platforms. This is great for low cost, quick turnaround publishing and works in the case of most coloring book styles. Here's the basic setup flow we'll use when creating these kinds of books.

- 1. Create your coloring book designs
- 2. Choose a POD platform
- 3. Prepare your files according to platform specifications
- 4. Upload your files and create product listings
- 5. Set pricing and royalties
- 6. Market your coloring books
- 7. Fulfill orders automatically through the POD platform

What You'll Need: Essential Resources

To begin your POD coloring book journey, you'll need:

- 1. **Design software**:
 - Adobe Illustrator (paid): <u>https://www.adobe.com/products/illustrator.html</u>
 - Al image generation software (free/paid options)
 - Inkscape (free): <u>https://inkscape.org/</u>
- 2. A computer with internet access
- 3. Basic understanding of file formats (PDF, PNG, JPEG)
- 4. An account on a POD platform (we'll cover options in Chapter 2)

Introduction To Amazon KDP

While there are many print on demand platforms, the most commonly used one is of course, Amazon's Kindle Direct Publishing (KDP). This is a top choice for many coloring book creators and here's why:

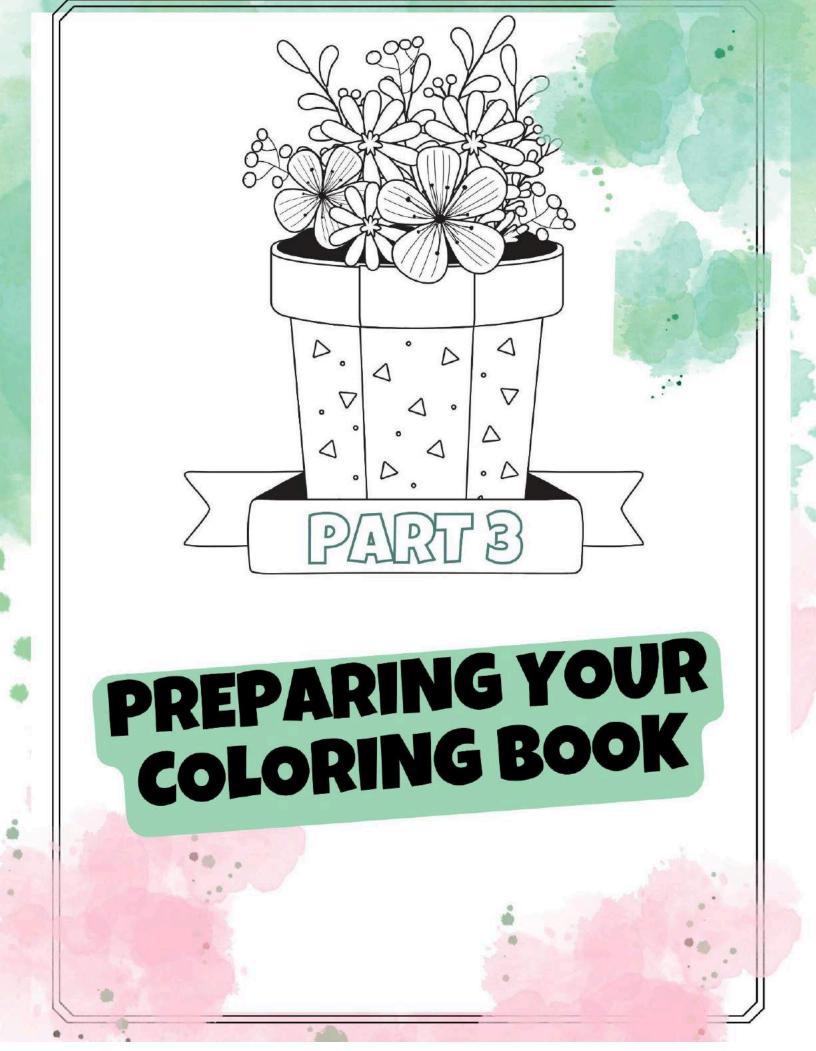
- Huge potential audience: Amazon is the world's largest online retailer
- Easy to use: Simple interface for uploading and managing your books
- No upfront costs: It's free to publish your coloring books
- Quick turnaround: Your book can be available for sale within 24-72 hours
- Decent print quality: Good enough for most coloring book needs
- Built-in marketing: Amazon's algorithms can help promote your book

As I mentioned earlier, there are other options depending on your type of content. If you're wanting to create Watercolor Coloring Books for example, we recommend a whole different platform and the setup and process varies considerably. Amazon KDP is great for regular coloring books, especially for children or adults using colored pencils. Mixed media or painting, we recommend you follow the training in <u>Watercolor Coloring</u> <u>Books</u> training.

Setting Up Your KDP Account

- 1. Visit <u>https://kdp.amazon.com</u>
- 2. Click 'Sign up' and use your existing Amazon account or create a new one
- 3. Fill in your author/publisher information and tax details

Preparing Your Coloring Book

Design Tools for Coloring Books

While traditional design software like Adobe Illustrator (paid) or <u>Inkscape</u> (free) can be used to create coloring books, there are also free online alternatives like <u>Photopea.com</u> that offer similar functionality.

However, for those who aren't confident in their design skills, AI image generation tools offer an exciting alternative. These tools can help you create unique and appealing coloring book pages with just a few text prompts.

AI Image Generation Tools for Coloring Books

5. NightCafe Studio Website: <u>NightCafe Studio</u>

Prompt examples:

- "Design a coloring page featuring a zentangle-inspired animal"
- "Create an outline drawing of a steampunk-themed machine"
- "Generate a black and white line art of a whimsical treehouse"
- 6. **Deep Dream Generator** Website: <u>Deep Dream Generator</u>

Prompt examples:

- "Transform a photo of flowers into a simple line drawing for coloring"
- "Convert an image of sea life into black and white outlines"
- "Turn a landscape photo into a sketch-like drawing with clear lines"

When using these tools, remember to adjust settings (if available) to create high-contrast, clear line drawings suitable for coloring. You may need to experiment with different prompts and settings to achieve the best results for coloring book pages.

While the free tools mentioned above can produce good results, Midjourney stands out as a premium option for those serious about creating exceptional coloring book images.

Although it comes with a cost, Midjourney's advanced AI capabilities allow you to generate stunning, detailed, and highly customizable illustrations perfect for coloring books. 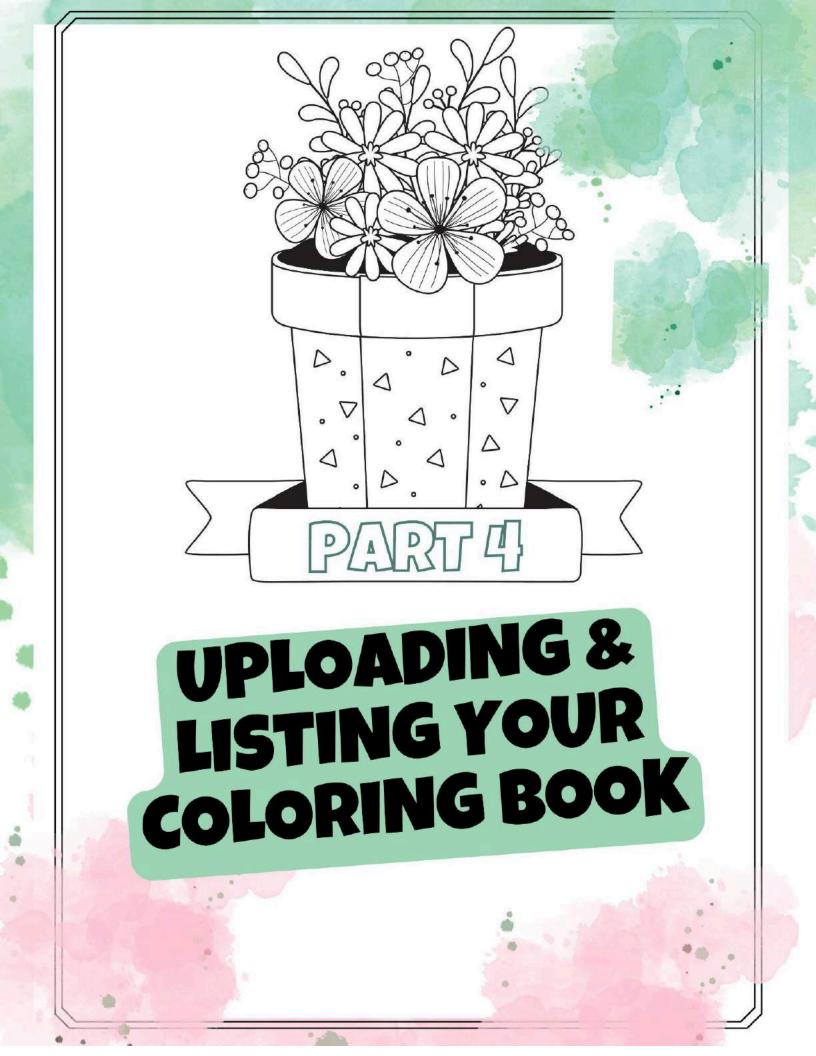

Uploading & Listing Your Coloring Book

Now that you've created your coloring book pages, it's time to get your book listed on Amazon KDP. This process is straightforward, but attention to detail is key.

Step 1: Log into Your KDP Account

Visit https://kdp.amazon.com and log in to your account.

Step 2: Create a New Paperback

From your KDP dashboard, click on '+ Create paperback'.

Step 3: Enter Your Book Details

Fill in the following information:

- Language
- Book title and subtitle
- Series information (if applicable)
- Edition number
- Author name
- Description (make it enticing!)
- Publishing rights
- Keywords (use coloring book-specific terms)
- Categories (choose appropriate coloring book categories)

Pro tip: Use keywords like "adult coloring book", "stress relief", or "mindfulness" to help your book appear in relevant searches.

Step 4: Set Up Your Print Options

Choose the following:

- ISBN (use Amazon's free ISBN as the easy option or add your own)
- Publication date
- Print options (color interior for coloring books)
- Paper type (white is better for coloring)
- Trim size (common sizes for coloring books: 8.5" x 11" or 8.25" x 8.25")
- Bleed settings (no bleed for most coloring books)
- Paperback cover finish (matte or glossy)

Step 5: Upload Your Content

- Interior file: Upload your PDF containing all your coloring pages
- Book cover: Use KDP's Cover Creator or upload your own design

Remember, your interior file should be:

- In PDF format
- 300 DPI resolution minimum
- RGB color space
- With embedded fonts

Step 6: Preview Your Book

Use KDP's online previewer to check how your book looks. Make sure all pages are in the correct order and the images look clear.

Step 7: Set Your Pricing

- Choose your primary marketplace
- Set your list price (consider your costs and competitor pricing)
- Decide on expanded distribution (optional)

Step 8: Submit for Review

Once you're happy with everything, click 'Submit for Review'. Amazon will review your book within 24-72 hours.

And that's it! You've successfully uploaded and listed your coloring book on Amazon KDP. Once approved, your book will be available for sale on Amazon's stores.

Remember, while this process works great for standard coloring books, specialized formats like watercolor coloring books (or anything in sub niches like mixed media/colored markers etc) will require different approaches. It's worth going through this process to familiarize yourself with how it all works, but if you really want to create these books that are in a less competitive and overloaded space - I know we keep banging on about it, but <u>Watercolor Coloring Books</u> is a great place to start!
